# Disbrow Cemetery, Mamaroneck, New York

## Introduction:

Disbrow Cemetery was established in Mamaroneck, NY in 1811. Disbrow Cemetery holds approximately 24 graves. They consist of:

- ❖ Disbrow Infant D.R.D.
- ❖ Disbrow Infant H.D.
- ❖ Disbrow Infant M.D.
- ❖ Unknown – Base with Inscription
- ❖ 14 Stone Markers

Disbrow is bounded by private residences on its north, east and west sides. It consists of a single rock wall on its east and west sides, a rock wall and a fence on its north side and a two-tier rock wall on its south side. An entrance and flight of rock stairs is located on the south side of Disbrow Cemetery. Rockland Avenue, a two lane road that connects with Boston Post Road (Route 1) is located directly south of Disbrow Cemetery.

It was an active burial ground from 1811 (tombstone no longer exists) to 1877. David H. Disbrow, a Commissioned Officer in the United States Army during the Civil War, was the last person buried at Disbrow Cemetery.



Flora consists of various types of grasses, moss, lichens, and several species of native trees. Fauna consists of the occasional squirrel and bird (e.g. crows, sparrows, and other native species).
