Introduction:

Florence/Powell Cemetery was established when Peter Florence was buried in Mamaroneck, NY plot of land shortly after his passing on November 30, 1808. Florence/Powell Cemetery holds approximately 15 graves. They consist of:

Florence/Powell is bounded by private residences on its north and west sides. The nearest road, Fulton Road, a one lane, one way street that connects to Palmer Avenue is located directly north of Florence/Powell Cemetery. An entrance ramp to Mamaroneck High School's parking lot runs directly east of Florence/Powell Cemetery and the Palmer Avenue Building of Mamaroneck High School and several parking spaces are located directly south of the Cemetery. The sole entrance is located on the south side of Florence/Powell Cemetery, which was an active burial ground from 1808 to 1883 with William J. Florence being the last person interred at the Cemetery.



Flora consists of various types of grasses, lichens, and several species of native trees and berry (black and red)-bearing bushes. Fauna consists of the occasional squirrel and bird (e.g. robins, sparrows, and other native species).


